


Christmas Gift Sale

Mrs Sandland is hoping to hold a mini Christmas Gift Sale for the children during this half term. It is something she usually organises with the school council in order to raise funds for our chosen charity.

In order to maintain as safe an environment as possible and minimise risk, the following procedures will be put
