Dear Parents,

I hope you have all had a wonderful summer break and that you and your children are looking forward to the new school term.

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for next week;

- The school day will be 8.30 3pm for everyone
- If possible, please support your child to carry out an LFD test before returning to school in order to avoid any asymptomatic cases in school
- Parents may come onto the top playground to drop off/collect children from 8.25/2.55 but in order to minimise numbers I would ask year 5 and 6 children to come in unaccompanied and to go straight into their respective classrooms.
 Children in year 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be collected from the playground by a member of staff at 8.30
- Children will return to daily Collective Worship in the hall but no parents in Friday celebration Collective Worship for first half term
- Children in years 1 to 6 to bring a pencil case into school to keep on their desk
- If a child/member of staff tests positive for covid, the parents of close contacts will be informed and asked to arrange a PCR test. There is no longer any requirement to self isolate while waiting for the result
- Please continue to send your child into school with a book bag/small draw string bag (not a rucksack)

Reminders:

- Long hair to be tied back
- No nail varnish
- Only fruit to be brought in for breaktime snack
- PE kit to be worn to school on PE days (you will be notified of these next week).

If you have any further questions please just ring/email school and I look forward to welcoming all the children back to school on Monday.
