

### Message from the CEO



To those pupils and families starting at one of our schools this September, we offer you a very warm welcome to your time at a Birmingham Diocesan Multi-Academy Trust (BDMAT) school. For those of you returning after the summer holiday I hope that you all managed to get some quality rest and time spent with loved ones.

The last two academic years have been dominated by the impact of COVID-19 and schools have looked very different to how we would have liked them to be. On 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021 the

government relaxed its guidance for schools, including ending the routine use of 'bubbles' to isolate pupils from one another. As the new rules came into force at the very end of term, we had no time to see how these would affect schools so please bear with our schools as they adapt to the new ways of working.

COVID-19 is still with us, and the country is expecting an increase in cases over the autumn and winter period as we start to spend more time indoors. Whilst we know that the virus is very rarely harmful to children, we still don't want the children to be poorly at all and therefore our schools will continue to be vigilant to the spread of the virus. In some cases where there are a number of cases at the same time in a school, we may need to reinstate restrictions, including potentially returning to operating in bubbles and phased starts / ends to the day, which is the current government guidance.

We ask parents also to continue to be vigilant and not send their children into school if they have the following symptoms:

- A new, continuous cough
- A high temperature
- Loss of smell and / or taste

We are pleased to announce two new schools that have recently joined our BDMAT family of schools. On 1st July 2021 we were joined by Bentley Heath CofE Primary School in Solihull.
